- To develop a clear understanding of the risks and rewards of running your own business




























Disadvantages of Running a Home Based Business

Business Plan

- A business plan is a tool used by people to document business objectives and propose how these objectives will be attained within a specific time.
- A business plan describes who are, what you plan to achieve, where your business will be located, when you expect to start, how you will overcome the risks involved and provide the returns anticipated.
- The business plan must also include detailed financial planning.

Market Research & Analysis

- Market research and analysis provides the business owner knowledge of their customer.
 - This information will determine the following:
- Who will buy their products or service?
- Where do customers live and what is their profile?
- $\,\blacksquare\,$ What factors influence the customers decision to buy.
- How often will customers buy?
- What are the customers preferences and needs?
- Can long term relationships be built?

Check Regulations

- Check and obtain all necessary licenses, permits and registrations for your specific line of business.
- This includes checking with your city planning and by law office to see if it is legal to operate your business from home.

Name Your Business

- A good business name can be an effective advertising tool. It should communicate something about your business
- the name chosen should be appropriate for the market you are competing in;
- it should be short and memorable;
- it should be distinctive enough to differentiate yourself from competitors;
- it must not infringe on an existing incorporated business name or trade-mark.

Register Your Business

- Everyone must register their home based business.
- A business name registration is valid for five years, after which time it must be renewed.

Taxation

- Check both federal and provincial taxation requirements with Canada Revenue Agency and the Provincial Retail Sales Tax Office.
- Inquire about allowable deductions for automobile expenses, business meals, entertainment and home office expenses.

Helpful Information

- Talk to owners of similar businesses. Learn as much as you can from them.
- Make use of free publicity.
- Self market yourself. Go to stores, companies and market your service or product in person.
- Learn basic management and bookkeeping skills.
- Have business cards, stationery and brochures printed professionally.
- Make sure your home work area is separate from the mainstream of your home.
