

# Introduction

Today in Northern Ontario there are 32 public libraries located in First Nation communities. With a total of 106 First Nation communities in the region, however, 70% are still without public libraries. This poster will describe the current situation of First Nation public libraries in Northern Ontario.

# Geographic Location

Of the 32 First Nation public libraries in Northern Ontario:


- 2 are located in fly-in communities

# **Current Structure and Operation**

### Hours

• First Nation public libraries are, on average, open 29 hours per week.

### **Facilities**

• More than 85% of First Nation libraries share a facility with another public service.

### **Funding**

- Public Library Operating Grant of \$1.50 per capita (Ministry of Culture)
- Salary Supplement Grant of \$13,000 (Ministry of Culture, for up to 50 libraries in Ontario)
- Due to a lack of tax revenue, First Nation communities are dependent on government funding for libraries
- Band Council support tends to take the form of in-kind contributions (rent, hydro, telephone, etc.)

### **Staffing**

• 97% of First Nation libraries in Northern Ontario are staffed by a single librarian

### **Governance Structure**

- First Nation libraries do not have boards, but rather are governed by the First Nation Band. The librarian is often under the supervision of the Education Director of the community.
- Most First Nation public libraries do not have independent governing authority with a mandate to approve the public library's budget.
- The governance or supervision of many First Nation public libraries by education programs and the subsequent location of public libraries in school buildings can make it challenging to establish a public library identity.
- The Indian Act requirement of Band Council elections every two years doubles the frequency of potential political turnover.

# Obtaining Provincial Funding

In Ontario, First Nation communities cannot receive provincial funding for a public library until one is already operating.

In order to be eligible for provincial funding, First Nation communities must send a Band Council Resolution (BCR) confirming the Band's:

- (i) commitment to establishing and operating a public library in accordance to the Public Libraries Act; and
- (ii) compliance with the Public Library Operating Grant (PLOG) program

Once libraries are in receipt of the Public Library Operating Grant, they are eligible for services provided by Ontario Library Service – North (OLS-North), an agency of the Ministry of Culture. OLS-North provides First Nation libraries with access to two advisors who assist them with: library practices, skills training, community development, funding opportunities, grant writing and more.

# Limits to Growth and Development

Despite an optimistic future, First Nation libraries face many challenges:

- Insecure funding
- Limited resources for staff salaries
- Geographic remoteness
- Lack of political support
- Small, inaccessible facilities
- Low profile in community

# Accomplishments

- 75% of First Nation public libraries in Northern Ontario have been operating for more than 15 years
- 50% of First Nation public libraries in Northern Ontario have been operating for more than 20 years
- Over 25% of First Nation librarians either have or are working towards their EXCEL Certificate in Managing a Small Public Library or their Library and Information Technician Diploma.

Enhance the delivery of services with a trained and stable workforce responsive to community needs.





#### Introduction:

#### What are Archives?

The term 'archives' can either refer to archival records or the physical location used to store the records such as a building or part of a building.

Definition from the Society of American Archivists Glossary:

(also archive), n. ~ 1. Materials created or received by a person, family, or organization, public or private, in the conduct of their affairs and preserved because of the enduring value contained in the information they contain or as evidence of the functions and responsibilities of their creator, especially those materials maintained using the principles of provenance, original order, and collective control; permanent records. − 2. The division within an organization responsible for maintaining the organization's records of enduring value. − 3. An organization that collects the records of individuals, families, or other organizations; a collecting archives. − 4. The professional discipline of administering such collections and organizations. − 5. The building (or portion thereof) housing archival collections. − 6. A published collection of scholarly papers, especially as a periodical.

#### SAA definition of Digital Archival Objects:

Digital archival objects include graphic images, audio or video clips, images of text pages, and electronic transcriptions of text. The objects can be selected examples, or digital surrogates of all the materials in an archival collection or series.

#### **Records and Primary Sources:**

**Records** are unpublished (primary source) materials that are created by organizations (governments, businesses etc)

and individuals. They come in many shapes and forms including text, audio/visual material, oral traditions, artifacts (wampum, totem poles etc).

A **primary source** is an original document created during a specific historical event (or function), by a known person or group (organization, community etc) and for a specific purpose. They are the main tool used by researchers, such as historians, to *write history*.

#### What is the Purpose of Records Management?

Aboriginal communities generate a lot of records in conducting their daily business. However, not all of these records have long-term value. They should be reviewed by community members on a regular basis in order to distinguish between what is kept, what is sent to the archives and what is destroyed.

Definition from the Society of American Archivists:

n.  $\sim$  the systematic and administrative control of records throughout their life cycle to ensure efficiency and economy in their creation, use, handling, control, maintenance, and disposition

### Why should they matter to Aboriginal Communities?

Archival records are used by all cultures and societies to transmit information from one generation to the next. They are *most* important to the community that originally used and created them. Up until recently aboriginal peoples have mainly existed in archives as the subjects of records meaning that the records were created to transmit information *about* them rather than

by them.

#### Accessing Archival Material on the Internet

The following are general steps that can be used to access archival material from the websites listed below. Each Repository has its own way of doings things so you may notice slight differences in search and browse methods.

(The example was deleted because it focused on the Archives of Ontario. Their website was recently redesigned and the steps are no longer valid) – Perhaps this is something future 2125 students can take up!

<u>General Guidelines</u>: (most of these are found in the pamphlet)

The following are general suggestions that will help you to access archival material on the internet.

- -Archival records are products of specific historical periods, keep this in mind as you search archival databases. For example, if your area of research is the early 20th century you may have better luck using "Indian" as a keyword instead of "Aboriginal."
- -When browsing your search results it is best to start at the 'group' (sometimes 'fonds' or 'creator') level and go from there. This provides you with more information about the records, associated records and their creator.
- -In some cases, the records that you want will be available online and you will be able to view them immediately. In

other cases, you will require the item number (if available) or box/container number to order the records. The archives may or may not copy and forward the records to you. If they do not provide such a service, you may have to view the material in person.

- -If you plan to visit the archives it is important that you request your materials ahead of time. This can usually be done online (website or e-mail) or by phone.
- -If you do consult with the reference archivist, make sure your question is detailed and clear. Suggest they help you with 'provenance' based searching; this will better serve the records and may leave you with a greater number of relevant resources.
- Lastly, remember to bring some government issued identification with you so that you can register as a researcher.
