Other Features

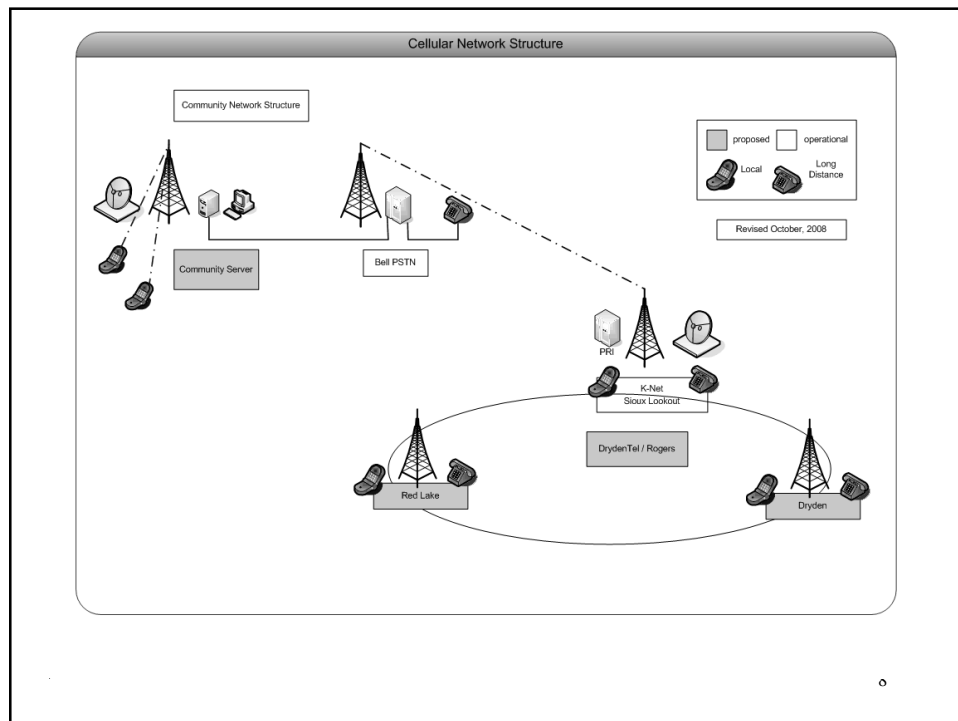
- Long distance & data
